

Care Homes COVID-19 Testing Pathway – East Berkshire, Surrey Heath, North East Hampshire & Farnham

<u>National route for requesting testing of residents and staff:</u> The main route for requesting testing of residents and staff is via the national programme. In England, all registered adult care homes can apply for coronavirus tests. This includes registered LD care homes. <u>Alternative to the national route:</u> Locally, within the Frimley ICS Geography (East Berkshire, North East Hants & Farnham, Surrey Heath), care homes experiencing any delays or difficulties using the national route can request a visit from our local provider to carry out testing. This is also open to Supported Living providers. See below for details.
