Pharmacists

- 1. Everyone Declaration of Competence (DoC) for Vaccination Services, available on the CPPE website, must be completed every **two** years.
- For those that should have had face to face training this year (those who last had face to face training in 2017). Complete Health Education England Immunisation module: <u>https://portal.e-lfh.org.uk/Catalogue/Index#</u> You will also need to complete the flu module once it has been updated for 2020 season.
- 3. For the NHS Advanced service there is NO requirement for annual refresher training or performing a certain number of vaccinations.
