Did you know if you use Proscript you can use it to pre-populate the PharmOutcomes flu service form with patient demographics?

To check your proscript system is enabled to do this, log on as supervisor and click on the settings cog (top right corner). Use the search facility to find PharmOutcomes and select Enabled – Yes.
You will need to reboot the computer after enabling. A more details ‘how to’ sheet to be available later this week.
