NHS Flu Season 2020/21 – Postcard 9

Flu service Last week was out busiest ever, with pharmacies giving over 12,800 flu vaccinations.

Mandatory Public Health campaign – Flu A resource pack for the campaign will start arriving in pharmacies by courier from 9 October. The pack includes a selection of posters to enable you to tailor your campaign depending on vaccine stock. At least one poster must be displayed for a period of one month (minimum). If you do not receive your pack by the 16th October 2020, email <u>partnerships@phe.gov.uk</u> with your pharmacy name, address and telephone number and state you have not received your Flu Vac campaign resources yet.

Supporting GP surgeries When completing a vaccination for a carer or living in a household with a shielded patient, add the name of the person being cared for/ shielding in the additional notes box at the end of the consultation. This helps the GP surgeries identify who is receiving and providing care that they may not know about.
