| Pandemic<br>Delivery<br>Service – CEV<br>patients   | Advanced<br>Service               | 31 <sup>st</sup> March | The pandemic delivery service has now ended for Clinically Extremely Vulnerable (CEV) patients. Make sure you claim for any deliveries made in March.  |                     |
| Pandemic<br>Delivery<br>Service – self<br>isolating | Advanced<br>Service               | 30 <sup>th</sup> June  | The Delivery service continues for those patients that need to self isolate. Patients will need to provide their Track & Trace ID reference number as proof of eligibility. Info <a href="https://example.com/here">here</a>   |                     |
| Pharmacy<br>Collect                                 | Advanced<br>Service               | 18 <sup>th</sup> April | NEW advanced service for collection of C-19 test kits from pharmacy. Register to provide service on MYS by 18 <sup>th</sup> April for £450 set up fee.   |                     |
|   |                                   |                        | C-19 test kits are ordered FOC from wholesaler (currently Alliance). NOTE ordering ONE from wholesaler will give you 54 boxes of 7 tests to give out. For more information click <a href="https://example.com/here/here/">here</a>   |                     |
| MYS access  | Pharmacy<br>Income                | 18 <sup>th</sup> April | From 18 April you will not be able to access the MYS portal using your Smartcard. You must register to access MYS using NHSmail login credentials.   |                     |

| Pharmacy<br>Quality Scheme<br>(PQS) Part 2          | Pharmacy<br>Income                | 30 <sup>th</sup> June  | Remember to complete the learning required for the first 3 domains by 30 <sup>th</sup> June and make sure Business Continuity Plans have been sent to your PCN lead.   |                     |
| CPCS GP<br>referrals –<br>pathway<br>engagement     | Advanced<br>Service               | 30 <sup>th</sup> June  | Complete the engagement activity listed in Annex F of the NHS CPCS service specification and claim a £300 activity payment. Claims available until 30 <sup>th</sup> June 2021 through the MYS portal.  |                     |
