| Eligible groups | Uptake ambition | Vaccination |
|-------------------------|--|---|
| Aged 65 years and over | At least 85% | aQIV (QIVc or QIVr when aQIV not available) |
| Aged under 65 'at risk' | At least 75% in all clinical risk groups | QIVc or QIVr (QIVe when others not available) |
| Aged 50 to 64 years | At least 75% | QIVc or QIVr (QIVe when others not available) |

2. Co-administration of Covid booster & flu

Studies are on-going to support co-administration of COVID-19 vaccines with influenza. Where co-administration does occur, patients should be informed about the likely timing of potential adverse events relating to each vaccine. Initial plans are being considered for co-administration for Trusts, residential care homes, housebound patients and other residential settings.
