- 1. NHS England have published the <u>PGD</u> for this year.
 - a. Please print, read, understand and sign the PGD.
 - b. Make sure any locums intending to deliver vaccinations in your pharmacy have also done so.
- 2. Make sure your DoC is up to date on your CPPE profile.
- 3. e-LfH flu modules have been updated with this year's info you may want to use this as part of your annual refresher https://www.e-lfh.org.uk/programmes/flu-immunisation/

- 5. Order any additional equipment you need to deliver the service.
- 6. PCN Leads Make contact with your PCN to discuss delivery. As last year, this is a requirement of a PQS domain. PCN target for over 65s vaccinated 80-86%.
 - a. All pharmacies wishing to claim this domain will need to administer a minimum of 30 flu vaccinations to qualify for a payment.
- 7. No further guidance yet on co-administration with Covid booster except for housebound, care home residents.
