

Who are CPSC?

Community Pharmacy South Central is your Local Pharmaceutical Committee (LPC). The LPC role is to represent all NHS pharmacy contractors in Hampshire and IoW. CPSC is recognised by local NHS Primary Care Organisations and is consulted on local matters affecting pharmacy contractors. We focus our activity on the following: effective participation in local commissioning; effective representation with stakeholders; effective engagement with and support for community pharmacies and community pharmacists.
